

2018- 2019 Outcomes for Pupils

The primary schools' performance data for 2019 has now been published and a summary is below. We are pleased with our data. As a growing school, there will always be variances between the attainment of different year group cohorts as the number of children is very small but the overall picture for Godmanchester Bridge Academy's pupils is positive and reflects the hard work of pupils, staff and parents/carers in supporting our children.
