ENGLISH

Text: The singing Mermaid

Reading: Julia Donaldson Stories

Writing: Narrative – focus on characterisation, instructions, poetry – revolting rhymes and a diary entry of the life of someone in a band.

Spelling: Spelling common exception words, spelling and using suffixes –ing, -ed, -er and –est, using expanded noun phrases, using commas in a list and using adverbs containing the suffix –ly.

MATHEMATICS

Addition and Subtraction: Using a blank number line to add and subtract 1 and 2 digit numbers. Using this knowledge to solve word problems.

Money: Identify each of the coins and notes used in our currency. Making the same amount using a range of coins.

Multiplication: Use an array to solve a range of calculations and problems.
