ENGLISH

Text: The egg

Reading: Tilly and the Time Machine

Writing: Narrative – fantasy tales, information texts about castles, diary entries.

Punctuation, Grammar and Spelling: possessive apostrophes, spelling common exception words, spelling words containing the suffixes –er, -est, -ed, -ing, -less, -ness, -ment, -ful and –ly.

MATHEMATICS

Shape: Looking at 3d shapes and their properties. How many edges, faces and vertices does it have?

Fractions: Finding $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$ and $\frac{2}{3}$ of a shape, quantity or number.

Measure: Length and Height.
