ENGLISH

Text: The light house keeper's lunch.

Reading: A range of poems about the seaside, a range of information texts about the seaside. Charlie and the chocolate factory.

Writing: Poetry in the style of talk for writing, narrative, information text about the seaside and writing postcards imagining we are at the beach.

Spelling: All objectives taught in the National Curriculum for Year Two.

MATHEMATICS

Position and Direction: Learning to use the language relating to the position and direction of an object. Learning what half turns, full turns and quarter turns clockwise and anti-clockwise are.

Problem Solving: Children will be using their knowledge and skills they have learnt throughout year 2 to solve problems.

TOPIC

Science: Animals including Humans.
