Aims

At Godmanchester Bridge Academy we aim to:

Areas of Display

At Godmanchester we share responsibility for the displays around school. There is an additional timetable made to show responsibilities and when the displays are due to be changed.

- **School Hall:** This is the responsibility of senior leadership team.
- **Corridors:** These areas are the responsibility of the appropriate year groups or subject leaders.
- **Classrooms:** These displays are the responsibility of individual class teachers to maintain and update as and when needed.

Expectations

- **Labelling:** All pieces should have the child’s name displayed with the piece of work. Complete displays are to have the year group clearly labelled and a title and brief explanation of the project displayed.
- **Mounting:** Art work on public display should be mounted.
- **Fabrics:** To be used at the discretion of the teacher.

Health and Safety

- Step ladders are provided to reach higher display boards.
- Staples and pins must be carefully removed and disposed of safely.
