

Godmanchester Bridge Academy Year 1 Curriculum Focus - Autumn



English:

In English this term the children have many writing opportunities, starting with Little Red Riding Hood. This is a traditional tale following the story of Little Red Riding Hood and her encounter with the Big Bad Wolf. We will also be looking at the non-fiction text Ice Planet Adventure Park and write our own sentences based on the facts we learn from the book!

Later in the term, we will look at Grandpa's Island. The story includes a pirate adventure and we will be using ideas from this story to inspire our own writing! For our non-fiction text, we will be looking at 'On safari' and the children will be writing a travel text.

Maths:

In Maths we begin the term by exploring place value within 10. During this topic we practise counting forwards and backwards to 10 and finding one more/one less. We then move on to addition and subtraction within 10. We use lots of practical materials to help us with our working out. To end the term we begin to explore place value within 20 and then focus on shape! This is another fantastically practical area of maths, which we love in Year 1.

Science:

- Body and Senses

- RE: We learn about people in Christianity.
- PSHE: Our topics are based on the idea of Beginning and Belonging and diversity and communities.
- Art and DT: We learn about drawing techniques and structures.

- Geography: We learn about the UK including our local area.
