Then we jump into non-fiction where we will be exploring holiday brochures linking with our history topic, 'Would you prefer to live in the Stone Age, Bronze Age or Iron Age'. The children will be writing a holiday brochure about the Stone Age settlement, Skara Brae. After half term, we begin our suspense text 'The Wolves in the Walls', before we end the term going underground where we will be exploring 'The Street Beneath My Feet'.
