Year 3 Curriculum Focus - Spring



English

In English this term, the children will have many writing opportunities. We start our learning with 'The Secret of Block Rock', this is an adventure story where the children can explore teamwork. Then we dive into non-fiction where we will be exploring 'The Street Beneath My Feet' which closely links to our science topic 'Rocks'. Finally, we grab our telescopes and search for the 'Star in The Jar'.

Maths

In Maths this term the children will have many opportunities to explore mathematical concepts. We start our learning by continuing to explore multiplication and division with a focus on our 8, 4 and 3 times tables. After half term, we focus on length and perimeter, the children will be given many hand on opportunities to explore measuring in real life, this will contextualise their learning. We then end the term by exploring fractions, it is important for your child to develop their confidence in Fractions for future success.

Science

In Science the term we will be exploring Animals Including Humans and Rocks.
