Year 1 Curriculum Focus - Spring



**English:**

In English this term the children have many writing opportunities, starting with *The Queen's Hat*. This is an adventure story where we follow the Queen's hat as it flies through London. Continuing on our London theme, we move on to reading a non-fiction text all about the Great Fire of London where we can show off our history knowledge. Later in the term, we write a story based on the fantastic *Wombat Goes Walkabout* and we end the term with another non-fiction piece of writing that links to our Science and Geography units on seasons.

**Maths:**

In Maths we begin the term by learning addition and subtraction within 20. We use lots of practical materials to help us with our working out. We then move on to place value within 50. During this topic we practice counting forwards and backwards and counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. To end the term we focus on length and height, weight and volume. This is another fantastically practical area of maths, which we love in Year 1.
