Year 6 Homework Letter



Reading

Research shows that the more exposure your child has to reading, the more academically able they will be. We recommend and encourage all children to read or be read to every day.

Children in Year 6 are expected to read for 30 minutes every day in order to meet their reading target. For those children reading long chapter books, this would be one book roughly every fortnight. Reading records are checked every Friday for a minimum of 5 recorded reads.

Spellings

Children in Year 6 will be set spellings every week, via ClassDojo. These will include several words to practise, which will be linked to our current spelling focus. Spellings will be tested every week.

Maths - Mathletics

Each week, children will be assigned 2-3 Mathletics activities which will be linked to our current Maths focus. Please check Class Dojo for details of the assigned activities. Children in Year 6 should be achieving a bronze certificate each week (1000 points).

Maths - TTRS

Times tables provide a vital foundation for many areas of mathematics and are key to success. Children in Year 6 should use Times Tables Rock Stars for 30 minutes each week in order to maintain fluency.

SATs & Transition

After Christmas, additional homework may be assigned each week in order to address any areas that need further practise ready for SATs and in order to prepare children for the homework demands of secondary school.
