## Year 3 Curriculum Focus - Spring



### English

In English this term, the children will have many writing opportunities. We start our learning with 'The Incredible Book Eating Boy', this is an humorous story where the children can really use their imaginations. Then we dive into non-fiction where we will be writing a diary based on 'The Journal of Illiona' - A young slave. Then, we grab our telescopes and search for the 'Star in The Jar'. Finally, we will write a non-chronological report on Earthquakes.

### Maths

In Maths this term the children will have many opportunities to explore mathematical concepts. We start our learning by continuing to explore multiplication and division with a re-cap on our 8, 4 and 3 times tables. After half term, we focus on length and perimeter, the children will be given many hand on opportunities to explore measuring in real life, this will contextualise their learning. We then end the term by exploring fractions, it is important for your child to develop their confidence in Fractions for future success.

### Science

In Science the term we will be exploring Rocks followed by Animals Including Humans.

Geography — Why do people live near volcanoes?

Art/D&T — Ancient Egyptian scrolls / Electronic charm

PSHE — Safety and the Changing Body/ My rights and responsibilities

Music — Composition and listening to music

Computing — Email and online safety/ Journey Inside a Computer

RE — Is scripture central to religion? / What happens if we do wrong?
