



## Godmanchester Bridge Academy Year 2 Curriculum Focus - Spring



### English

In English this term, we are writing a traditional tale with a twist, based on Little Red Reading Hood by Lucy Rowland. We will also write a recount of events from the perspective of astronaut Neil Armstrong.

In Spring 2, we will write a fable based on the Native American myth The Crows Tale. We will also write a persuasive letter inspired by The Day the Crayons Quit by Drew Daywalt.

### Maths

In Maths this term, we are learning how to count money, starting multiplication and division, and extending our knowledge of length and height, and mass, capacity and temperature.

### Science

In Science this term we will be learning about the uses of everyday materials. We will identify, compare, and clarify materials by recording observations, discuss appropriate use and investigate squashing, bending, twisting and stretching wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard.
